STANDARDS

One of the standout additions is the introduction of **three new technology domains: big data, ethics, and infrastructures**. Now, users can delve into specific technology domains to uncover standards tailored to their areas of interest and expertise.

Another notable addition is the filter by **"scope"**, allowing users to refine their search results based on the specific focus areas and applications of the standards they are seeking.

Furthermore, each standard listing now includes a **direct link to the standard**, enabling users to access further details or directly download the standard.

Finally, users can now easily identify the most recent iterations of standards with the inclusion of the **details of the version of the standard**. Staying informed about the latest updates and revisions has never been easier, ensuring users always have access to the most up-to-date information.
