### GLOSSARY AND TAXONOMIES

As of the 1st of January 2024, the **Taxonomy for CCAM**, developed by the FAME project is publicly available! This taxonomy has been developed to establish a standardised and harmonised classification system for the variety of CCAM terms. This supports in enhancing the comparability, complementarity, and expansion of research, development, and testing in the field of CCAM-enabled solutions and services.

However, the field of CCAM is ever-changing and therefore the taxonomy is a living tool. Regular updates will follow according to new initiatives, research, and changes in the field of CCAM. The content is built upon established standards and taxonomies from organisations like <u>SAE</u>, <u>ISO</u>, and <u>UNECE</u>, the FAME glossary, research documents and consortium initiatives, ensuring alignment with established frameworks. Following a systematic and hierarchical approach, the taxonomy classifies and categorises terms with

ontology software. This ontology approach makes the terminology easily navigable and depicts the relationships and interactions between terms. Lastly, the taxonomy has close links with the development of a <u>Common Evaluation Methodology</u> (CEM). A significant part of its terminology is therefore adopted within the tool.

### **TAXONOMY**

A newly updated **glossary** is available, which it is in essence an extract of the taxonomy. Similar to the taxonomy this glossary is a living source which will be updated in parallel with the taxonomy continuously, according to the dynamic changing field of CCAM.

The updated glossary is made available on the Knowledge Base.
